Our property rights attorneys also assist clients in asserting inverse condemnation claims where the condemning authorities' activities resulted in a taking of private property without formal condemnation proceedings.

For condemnors, we provide analysis regarding statutory authority, project planning, and acquisition negotiations. If the matter proceeds to a condemnation action, we handle all aspects of litigation, from constitutional challenges to valuation.

Under the direction of our attorneys, the consultants analyze the taking of the property, the impact that the taking will cause to any remainder property, and the amount of compensation owed to the condemnee.

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
